The best way to see the Bay of Islands is from the water, and the nicest way to see it is by sailing a Tall Ship. This morning you will board the R. Tucker Thompson a spacious vessel, with plenty of room to relax, read a book and soak up the sun. At lunchtime, you will find a sheltered cove and you can head ashore, have a swim or stay on board and have a drink. On the way back, a delicious BBQ lunch will be served, tender barbequed chicken on a delicious salad and crusty french bread.
